APTCOO Ofsted Report July 2023

As you may be aware there is an increase in Covid cases both nationally and locally. The new

strain 'Eris' is currently being monitored by the UK Health Secuity Agency (UKHSA) but at

present there are no recommendations to commence routine testing in schools. The new

variant has however prompted the acceleration of the vaccine programme and the UKHSA

are urging everyone to eligible to come forward. As a precautionary measure we do have to

be mindful of our families with a member of the household that are classified as 'clinically

vulnerable.' With this in mind can we please ask that if you suspect that your young person

is feeling unwell to test in the first instance. We will be sending home testing kits this week
